Resolution on Umno's entry to State

SANTUBONG, Sun. - Delegates attending the convention of Parti Pesaka Bumiputera Bersatu here today agreed that the question of Umno's entry into Sarawak did not arise and that the existing understanding between PBB and Umno be maintained.

This was one of the resolutions adopted by the delegates at the convention.

The resolution condemned any efforts by any quarter which wanted to create political instability in the State and undermine the strength of the PBB.

In another resolution, the delegates gave their support to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad and his deputy, Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim, in tackling the economic downturn.

They also gave their full support to Chief Minister Tan Sri Abdul Taib Mahmud in overcoming the economic problems affecting the State.

They also wanted the Federal and State Governments to take stern action against anyone found to be sabotaging the country's economy.
