ROC turns 100

THE Registry of Companies (ROC) will be a century old this year and to commemorate the event, a two-day international conference on a theme close to its heart - 'Corporate Governance: Responsibilities, Risks and Reform' - will be held on July 7 in Kuala Lumpur.

Aiding the ROC in organising the conference are six professional bodies and industry groups, namely, the Federation of Public Listed Companies, the Malaysian Institute of Directors, the Malaysian Association of the Institute of Chartered Secretaries and Administrators (MAICSA), the Malaysian Bar Council, the Malaysian Institute of Accountants, and the Malaysian Association of Certified Public Accountants.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad will launch the conference which is the highlight of the ROC's centennial celebrations. Speakers include Datuk C.Rajandram, CEO of Rating Agency Malaysia Bhd; Stephan Adamson, a partner in Ernst & Young International; Professor Thomas Clark of Leeds Business School; and Howard Morris, a partner in the International Insolvency Practice of Denton Hall.
