Sanusi urges party members to undergo self-reformation

ALOR STAR, Wed. - Umno members need to undergo self-reformation if the party is to be credible, trustworthy and able to produce leaders of the future, Menteri Besar Tan Sri Sanusi Junid said.

He said Umno members should assess themselves and determine how they could change to become better individuals and more beneficial to the party.

"Every party member should take a close look at himself and list out the things that they need to reform. Only then can the party be assured of a bright future," he said.

In line with this, Sanusi said Kedah Umno would be conducting a "self reformation camp" at Pedu Lake in Kuala Nerang from Sept 25 to 28.

He said State Umno leaders, including those from the Youth and Wanita wings, would attend the camp.

The Menteri Besar said this after chairing the State Exco meeting at Wisma Darul Aman.

Asked to comment on reports that scores of Indonesians had protested outside the Malaysian embassy in Jakarta demanding Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir's resignation, Sanusi said:

"The more ignorant they are, the more vehemently they protest ... In this case they are very ignorant about the issues in Malaysia but yet they want to participate.

"They are participating in issues which they don't know about."

He said the people should not lose focus about what was happening in the country and urged them to concentrate on their responsibilities.
