Seat of former DPM shifted to Block E

DATUK Seri Anwar Ibrahim's seating position in the Dewan Rakyat has been shifted to Block E, behind Ilani Datuk Ishak (BN-Kota Baru).

His seat was previously next to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad on Block A, which is now left vacant.

The sacked Deputy Prime Minister, who is Permatang Pauh MP, is now an independent. He was expelled from the Government on Sept 2 and from Umno the following day.

His seat in the Dewan now is with former DAP national vice-chairman Liew Ah Kim and sacked former Gerakan MP for Batu Datuk Joseph Chong Chek Ah.

DAP deputy secretary-general and Kota Melaka MP Lim Guan Eng, who is serving a jail sentence, retains his place in Block F, in between the Bagan MP Lim Hock Seng and Cheras MP Tan Kok Wai.

Special Functions Minister Tun Daim Zainuddin (BN-Merbok) is now seated next to Gerakan president Datuk Seri Dr Lim Keng Yaik (BN-Beruas) at Block A.

Daim was previously seated on the first row in Block C, together with former Deputy Prime Minister Tun Ghafar Baba (BN-Jasin).
