Signature campaign to be extended nationwide

KUALA LUMPUR, Tues. - The on-going Barisan Nasional Youth signature campaign will be conducted nationwide from next week, in a move to collect one million signatures from patriotic Malaysians.

BN Youth secretary Zulkifli Alwi said the 14 coalition members would set up their own campaign centres in strategic areas, to encourage the public "to express their support for the Government".

"Malaysians, especially the `silent majority', had been keeping quiet all this while simply because they loved the country and did not wish for any unfortunate incidents.

"However, the recent developments have changed their perception and patriotic Malaysians are now coming forward to express their support for Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad's leadership and their disgust over foreign interference in the country's internal affairs."

Zulkifli said since the campaign was launched on Nov 18, Umno Youth's campaign centre at level 2 of the Putra World Trade Centre here, had received about 37,000 signatures from patriotic Malaysians.

This figure also includes those who had called the movement's 10 hotline numbers to convey their messages.
