State Youth wing pledges to ensure polls victory

KOTA KINABALU, Fri. - Sabah Barisan Nasional Youth today pledged to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad the movement's commitment to ensure a BN victory in the State election.

The movement also pledged to uphold the country's sovereignty against undesirable elements from within or outside the nation, protect the country's religious harmony from being used for political purposes and to ensure freedom of worship.

Sabah BN Youth further stressed its commitment to maintain healthy living and to reject "street politics".
