STUDENTS INTERVIEW MAHATHIR AT MULTI-MEDIA FORUM

KUALA LUMPUR, NOV 15 (Bernama) -- Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad today was interviewed by three students at the Apec MSC-VTM (virtual trade mission) global interview, a multi-media forum which allows school students from Malaysia and other Apec economies to interview Apec economic and business leaders.

The interview will be telecast in member economies and can also be accessed through the Internet.

Dr Mahathir was interviewed by VTM Foundation president Noel Gould, Universiti Tenaga Nasional's Idran Rabihah Zakaria, and Sara Isherwodd of the International School here.

The 15-minute session was conducted after the Prime Minister opened the Apec Business Summit.

Dr Mahathir was asked of his opinion on human rights, Internet usage as a tool of communication, currency trading and developments that led to the introduction of exchange control regulations.
