Students involved in movement will lose scholarships

SHAH ALAM, Wed. - Selangor Government will withdraw scholarships awarded by Yayasan Selangor to students to pursue their tertiary education, if they are found to be involved in the so-called reformation movement of former Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim.

Menteri Besar Datuk Abu Hassan Omar, warning the scholarship holders to stay away from the ceramah on so-called reformation movement, told them to concentrate on their studies and career instead.

Speaking to reporters after launching the State-level freshwater fish food promotion at Intekma Resort today, Abu Hassan said he had also advised Umno leaders and members, including the Youth and Wanita wings, to stay away from the ceramah and not to buy tapes containing Anwar's speeches.

He urged all Umno division and branch leaders as well as the members to heed party president Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad's statement that "the truth will prevail".
