Syed Hamid: Be wary of those out to create trouble

SHAH ALAM, Wed. - Umno Supreme Council member Datuk Seri Syed Hamid Albar has urged Malaysians not to be misled by irresponsible and unscrupulous people who were out to cause unrest and riots.

"There are all sorts of allegations on the Internet. People must think for themselves and act wisely. Do not fall victim to false information," he said.

Syed Hamid reiterated that since Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim has been charged in court, people should be calm and patient and await the outcome of the trial.

"Now that Anwar has been charged in court, it is only proper that the process of law be allowed to go on without any untoward incidents.

"Anwar's supporters must be calm and patient and await the outcome of the trial," he said after attending a dinner hosted by the Sultan of Selangor last night.
