Tenaga urged to check on street lights

TENAGA Nasional Berhad has been urged to establish a patrol unit to monitor the condition of street lights in the Senawang area.

Woo Ah Lek (BN-Senawang) said residents were concerned about the frequent breakdown of street lights as it could result in a rise in break-ins and petty crimes.

Debating the royal address by the Regent of Negri Sembilan Tunku Naquiyuddin Tuanku Ja'afar at the opening of the Budget session, he said he had received frequent complaints from residents and urged Tenaga Nasional to take immediate action.

"In view of Visit Negri Sembilan Year next year, I feel the basic amenities, such as street lights, must always be in proper working order."

Woo, who is also the State Gerakan party chief, pledged full support to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad and criticised US Vice-President Al Gore's statement supporting the reformasi movement.
