UGANDAN PRESIDENT LEAVES FOR HOME

KUALA LUMPUR, April 19 (Bernama) -- Ugandan President Yoweri Kaguta Museveni left for home today after a four-day state visit to Malaysia.

He was seen off at the airport by Energy, Telecommunications and Posts Minister Datuk Leo Moggie, who is minister-in-attendance.

Before his departure, the president was presented with a photo album containing photographs taken throughout his visit. The photos were taken by the Information Department and presented to him by Moggie.

Museveni's visit was at the invitation of the Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Ja'afar.

While here, Museveni held talks with Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad, capped with the signing of two agreements in trade as well as economic, technology and cultural cooperation.
