UMNO SEC-GEN TO OPEN IPF MEETING

KUALA LUMPUR, March 18 (Bernama) -- The Indian Progressive Front (IPF) will embark on a nation-wide campaign for members to donate cash and jewellery to boost the country's reserves, its president M G Pandithan said today.

He said the campaign would kick off at the seventh IPF general assembly on March 29 here.

More than 2,000 delegates are expected to attend the one-day meeting to be opened by Culture, Arts and Tourism Minister and Umno secretary-general Datuk Sabbaruddin Chik.

Pandithan said a motion of support for Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad and his deputy Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim in overcoming the country's financial and economic problems would also be tabled at the meeting. -- BERNAMA
