LEAD UNGA-Visit  
UNGA PRESIDENT TO VISIT MALAYSIA TOMORROW

KUALA LUMPUR, March 11 (Bernama) -- The President of the 52nd Session of the United Nations General Assembly, Hennadiy Udovenko, will make a three-day official visit to Malaysia beginning tomorrow.

According to a Wisma Putra statement issued here today, Udovenko, who is Ukraine Foreign Minister, is scheduled to meet Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad and Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim to exchange views on various issues of interests to Malaysia and Ukraine at the UN.

Udovenko is also scheduled to hold talks with Foreign Minister Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi.

He would visit the UN office here, the Kuala Lumpur City Centre, the Proton plant and the National Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Malaysia, the statement said.

It said that Udovenko would also meet members of the Governing Council of the UN Association of Malaysia (UNAM) at a luncheon organised in his honour.

Prior to being assigned as Ukraine Foreign Minister in September 1994, he was Ukraine's ambassador to Poland from 1992 to 1994. -- BERNAMA
