US CONGRESS DELEGATION DUE TOMORROW

KUALA LUMPUR, Jan 6 (Bernama) -- A United States congressional delegation, led by chairman of the House National Security Committee Floyd Spence, is due here tomorrow for a two-day visit.

" This visit to the region will enable Spence to focus on regional security issues and other areas of concern to the Committee, such as military training and operations and basing agreements," the US Information Service said today.

Spence has been a strong proponent of increased defense spending, it said in a statement.

While here, the delegation is scheduled to meet Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad and Defence Minister Datuk Syed Hamid Albar to discuss bilateral ties and regional issues.

The delegation will also visit Indonesia and Australia. -- BERNAMA
