WANITA UMNO TO ACT AGAINST MEMBERS INVOLVED IN REFORM MOVEMENT

JOHOR BAHRU, Sept 27 (Bernama) -- Wanita Umno will act against members found to be involved in Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim's reform movement, its chief Datuk Dr Siti Zaharah Sulaiman said today.

However, so far no reports had been received of Wanita Umno members' involvement in the former deputy prime minister's movement, she said.

Dr Siti Zaharah said Wanita Umno would explain Anwar's removal from the Cabinet and Umno, to its members at the divisional and branch levels.

She was speaking to reporters after launching the Pulai Wanita Umno Division Open Day which was also attended by Information Minister and Pulai Umno division chief Datuk Seri Mohamed Rahmat, and Johor Wanita Umno chief Datuk Sabariah Ahmad.

Dr Siti Zaharah also advised Anwar's wife Datin Seri Dr Wan Azizah Wan Ismail accept her husband's removal rationally and leave it to the courts to decide on the allegations that had been made against him.

She said Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad would not have dismissed Anwar if there was no concrete evidence supporting the allegations.
