World students' conference

HARVARD Project for Asian and International Relations conference will be held in Kuala Lumpur from May 28 to 31. For the first time, it will be participated by Malaysian delegates. A statement released in Kuala Lumpur yesterday said that Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad will address the assembly of the world's student leaders entitled "Asia in Transition: Beyond the Miracle." A total of 180 international students including 50 Malaysian students from the world's leading universities namely Harvard, Yale, Oxford, Cambridge, Tokyo University, The National University of Singapore and local universities will participate in the conference. The conference is aimed at engaging the future leaders in discussions that demonstrate the complexity of the international relations and to gain a profound understanding of critical issues.
