ZAHID: TERENGGANU UMNO YOUTH AGREES WITH DR MAHATHIR

KUALA TERENGGANU, Sept 13 (Bernama) -- Terengganu Umno Youth agrees with party president Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad that Datuk Ahmad Zahid Hamidi should have resigned as Umno Youth leader in accordance with the wishes of the majority of Youth Exco members.

"Zahid should have considered the movement's struggle, not siding with former deputy prime minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim in his call for reforms," said its leader Abd Rahin Mohd Said when contacted today.

He said Zahid had acted contrary to the decision of the Umno Supreme Council of which he was a party in dismissing Anwar on Sept 4.

Abd Rahin also said there was no need for Umno Youth members to support the reforms called by Anwar since Umno had been doing it.

"There is nothing new about it," he said.

He said they should think of the problems they might face if they continued to be with Anwar in his struggle for political reforms.
