

# BN manifesto 'designed to benefit all'

MARAN: The Barisan Nasional Government will continue to emphasise on good virtues to ensure racial harmony prevails in the country, Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad said yesterday.

The Prime Minister said the **Barisan** manifesto had

never been designed to incite ill-feelings that could lead to racial violence.

Nor had the manifesto attempted to create religious ill-will by harping on misconceptions that a particular state had more churches than mosques.

"Let's not hurt the feel-

ings of fellow Malaysians.

We want the people to benefit from the Barisan Government, that's all," he said.

Speaking to reporters after a meet-the-people session at Bandar Baru Jengka here, Dr Mahathir said the Government

would continue with 'the policies which had been effective in bringing the people together.

In his speech earlier, Dr Mahathir said the people should be thankful for the harmony and economic prosperity enjoyed under the ruling Government.
