ADNAN TO MEET BN ELECTED REPS ON TUESDAY

KUANTAN, Nov 13 (Bernama) -- Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Adnan Yaakob will meet on Tuesday incumbent Barisan Nasional (BN) elected representatives from the state to convey Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad's message.

"Dr Mahathir's message is that we must accept the reality that some of us may not be renominated," he told reporters after meeting RTM staff here today.

He hoped excluded incumbents would be magnanimous to come forward to assist newcomers to ensure their victory in the Nov 29 general election.

"They must not forget that other people helped them when they were contesting and now it's their turn to help others," said Adnan, who is also Pahang Umno Information chief.

He said he would draw up the candidates' list after consulting State Umno and BN chief Tan Sri Khalil Yaakob, who is also Umno secretary-general.

He said Umno divisions had been asked to recommend their choice of candidates to him.

He said the State Umno liaison committee meeting would be held in Kuala Lumpur tomorrow to discuss election matters.

Pahang has 38 state and 11 parliamentary seats.

Leong Ngah Ngah, the assemblyman for Triang, is the sole DAP representative in the state legislature.
