APPOINT OUR LEADERS AS SENATORS - PPP YOUTH

KUALA LUMPUR, Dec 18 (Bernama) -- PPP Youth wants party president Datuk M.Kayveas to be given an "important" cabinet post and other PPP leaders made senators.

Youth chief T. Murugiah said such appointments would enable PPP to better serve the people as a component party of the Barisan Nasional (BN).

"We hope (Prime Minister and BN chairman Datuk Seri) Dr Mahathir Mohamed can allot a few senatorships to PPP leaders to enable them to provide necessary services to party members and the public," he told a news conference.

Murugiah said PPP would continue to support the BN despite not being offered any seats to contest in the Nov 29 general election.

"This is the right time for us to help the BN regain control of the two states (Kelantan and Terengganu) ruled by the opposition," he said.

PPP Youth, he said, would submit proposals to Dr Mahathir on how the BN could wrest the two states from PAS.

One suggestion, he said, was to encourage more Chinese and Indian Malaysians to settle in the two states to reduce the proportion of people who could be influenced by PAS.

Murugiah also said that Dr Mahathir had been invited to attend PPP's new year open house celebrations at the Putra World Trade Centre on Jan 1.
