Ling-Voters

AVOID EXPERIMENTS WHEN CHOOSING GOVERNMENTS- DR LING

PULAU PINANG, Nov (Bernama) -- The people should avoid experiments when choosing governments for if they do that they will gamble away their future resulting in a bleak future for the next generation, MCA President Datuk Seri Dr Ling Liong Sik said today.

Some people were talking about giving a try to other parties but this could be dangerous as these parties would not have the ability to bring development to the country and people, he said.

The Barisan Nasional (BN) had a good record of service and all communities were comfortable with it and even foreigners were amazed by its success, he said before inspecting MCA election operation rooms in Penang.

For 42 years, the BN had impressed the entire world through its ability to rule and bring development to the country and its multiracial and multireligious population, he said.

He said there had been instances of foreigners coming to Malaysia to find out the secret of Malaysia's success.

The people should consider carefully and rationally whether to choose Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad or Datuk Nik Aziz Nik Mat for Prime Minister.

For if the choice is Nik Aziz, then there was no doubt he would continue with his plan to set up an Islamic state and enforce Hudud Laws in Malaysia, Dr Ling said.

Every Malaysian Chinese must realise that a vote for the DAP was a vote in support of PAS, Nik Aziz and an Islamic state, Dr Ling said.

"I am certain that the Malaysian Chinese will stand solidly behind Dr Mahathir."

"For I am confident that the Alternative Front Government will collapse on very the first day of the Dewan Rakyat sitting following a heated debate between Nik Aziz who wants to set up an Islamic State and DAP Secretary-General Lim Kit Siang who is opposed to the idea," the MCA President said.

"Surely Kit Siang will withdraw his party from the Government and a new general election will have to be held to set up a more credible government," Dr Ling said.

During Monday's vote, women would wield considerable power and play a very significant role as they would determine the victory or defeat of a particular candidate, he said.

Women made up the majority of voters in many constituencies and overall they made up 59 of the total electorate, he said.

Like Wanita Umno the Wanita MCA had given its members the opportunity to be active and provide service to the people, he added.

Dr Ling also blasted Lim Kit Siang and Karpala Singh for setting up what he called "Perniagaan Keluarga Sdn Bhd" by fielding their family members as candidates in the election.
