BN'S GOOD TRACK RECORD WILL ENSURE CHINESE VOTES, SAYS PERAK ACC

IPOH, Nov 18 (Bernama) -- The Perak Chinese Chamber of Commerce (ACC) reckons that Barisan Nasional's (BN) good track record in managing the economy and nation will guarantee the votes of the Chinese community in the state in the coming general election.

ACC president Goh Chor Jim said today the excellent leadership by the government, especially in pulling the country out from its worst economic problem recently, had impressed Perak's Chinese community.

"The Chinese community in Perak fully supports Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad and his excellent handling of the nation's economy," he told Bernama at his office, here.

Goh said the Chinese community here appreciated the government's economic policy during the crisis which saw the introduction of the much-criticised capital controls, low interest rates and availability of loans and would like to see the continuation of good leadership in the BN.

He also praised MCA president Datuk Seri Dr Ling Liong Sik for being an exemplary leader.

He said the power- and wealth-sharing system practised by the BN government had proven its worth in maintaining political stability in Malaysia.
