Be united, Barisan component parties told

LABUAN, Fri. - Barisan Nasional component parties should be united to ensure that the same spirit is instilled among the people to enable development to be carried out effectively.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad said BN leaders should work together to ensure that Sabah would not be left out of the mainstream of development.

He said programmes to ensure development in Sabah could be carried more efficiently if BN leaders were united.

The Prime Minister said this in his message in a souvenir programme to mark the Sabah Progressive Party's sixth annual congress at the Labuan Financial Park auditorium tomorrow.

Party president Datuk Yong Teck Lee will deliver a policy speech when opening the congress.

Dr Mahathir commended SAPP leaders for their role in helping the BN win the State election in March.

"I believe SAPP can carry out its responsibility to help unite the people in Sabah. Victory for the BN in the coming general election will depend on the co-operation and hard work of BN component leaders."

Some 2,000 delegates from all over the State will attend the congress. This is the first time SAPP is holding its annual congress in Labuan.
