BN YOUTH CONVENTION IN KOTA KINABALU NEXT MONTH

KUALA TERENGGANU, May 1 (Bernama) -- The Barisan Nasional Youth Convention to be held in Kota Kinabalu in the middle of next month will discuss strategies to face the opposition attacks, its acting chief Datuk Hishamuddin Tun Hussein said today.

He said the attacks were not only aimed at creating problems for Umno but also to jeopardise the people's unity.

"We will use the BN's right wing to ably handle the various issues raised by the opposition and ensure that the BN receives the people's support in the general election," he said.

Hishamuddin was speaking to reporters after closing the Terengganu Umno Youth gathering attended by some 1,600 Umno Youth members from the state.

He said Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad had agreed to open the convention.
