BRITISH AIRWAYS CHIEF TO VISIT MALAYSIA

KUALA LUMPUR, June 3 (Bernama) -- British Airways chairman Lord Marshall and representaives from several prominent British companies will visit Malaysia during June 7-9, the British High Commission here said in a statement today.

The visit is centred on Kuala Lumpur during which Marshall will act as an ambassador for the British business community, the High Commission said.

He is expected to acquire a comprehensive understanding of the many commercial and investment opportunities currently available in Malaysia and to bring them to the attention of all relevant parties on his return to the UK.

Marshall is scheduled to meet Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad, First Finance Minister Tun Daim Zainuddin, Transport Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ling Liong Sik and International Trade and Industry Minister Datuk Seri Rafidah Aziz.

He will also address the monthly luncheon of the British Malaysian Industry and Trade Association, which will soon be known as the British Malaysian Chamber of Commerce, which will be attended by senior local and foreign businessmen.

The visit is arranged by the British High Commission to promote the British industry as a whole. -- BERNAMA
