BN'S LINEUP BETTER THAN IN 1995 - WAN MOKHTAR

CUKAI, Nov 20 (Bernama) -- Menteri Besar Tan Sri Wan Mokhtar Ahmad said the Barisan Nasional (BN) candidates' lineup for the 10th general election is better than the 1995 general election list.

He said this was because that all candidates selected received solid support from all BN members including those dropped from the lineup.

"We are confident that the BN will win the Nov 29 general election and regain the seats lost in 1995," he said after completion of the nomination process for the Cukai state constituency at the Kemaman District Office, here, today.

Wan Mokhtar who is contesting the constituency for the sixth consecutive term after winning the Cukai seat since 1974, will face Kemaman PAS head Awang Jusoh in a straight fight.

He said among the BN's priority areas was the Marang parliamentary seat as PAS had placed its deputy president Abdul Hadi Awang to stand there.

Abdul Hadi will also contest the Ru Rendang state constituency with Mustafa Ali in Pengkalan Berangan. Both areas are under the Marang parliamentary constituency.

Wan Mokhtar advised all candidates in the Nov 29 general election to behave themselves with dignity.

He said BN chairman Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad would be in Terengganu on Nov 25 to help in the campaigning.
