Business forecast seminar on Aug 27

STRATEGIC Intelligence (M) Sdn Bhd expects at least 300 local and foreign top brass from the academic and corporate world to attend the Malaysian Business Forecast seminar on Aug 27 in Kuala Lumpur.

Invited panellists for this session includes Krugman, Bank Negara Governor Tan Sri Ali Abul Hassan Sulaiman, NEAC working group member Datuk Dr Zainal Aznam Yusof and Andersen Consulting managing partner Larry Gan.
