Call for clean campaign

SHAH ALAM, Thurs. - MCA secretary-general Datuk Dr Ting Chew Peh today reminded all party leaders and members campaigning for positions in the forthcoming divisional meetings not to hurl slanderous remarks, run down or discredit contestants and to refrain from money politics.

"Those vying for positions can use their own track record to campaign but they are to strictly abide by the party's do's and don'ts, failing which disciplinary action will be taken against those who flout the directives."

Dr Ting said the MCA Election Steering committee would closely monitor all campaigning activities, and complaints filed would be studied and if substantiated, would be referred to the party's disciplinary committee for further action.

Speaking to reporters when met at the opening of the Selangor Umno building by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad today, Dr Ting said there would be a contest for various divisional positions in 43 of the 165 MCA divisions on Sunday.
