Chandra: PM to call general election soon

SEREMBAN, Sun. - Parti Keadilan Nasional deputy president Dr Chandra Muzaffar has claimed that Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad will hold the general election soon, to take advantage of the wide publicity on troubles within the Opposition.

Chandra also accused the Barisan Nasional leaders of blowing up misunderstandings between Pas, DAP, Keadilan and Parti Rakyat Malaysia.

He said the BN leaders were using the media to achieve this, adding that it was an example of dirty politics at work in the country.

At the launch of Keadilan's Seremban division last night, Chandra said issues such as the rotation system for the post of Prime Minister, the "Malaysian Malaysia" concept and that of the Islamic state were blown up to discredit the Opposition.

In defending Pas' objective to form an Islamic state, he said every party was entitled to its own manifesto.
