Chief Emeka Anyaoku arrives for four-day visit

KUALA LUMPUR, Fri. - Commonwealth Secretary-General Chief Emeka Anyaoku arrived tonight for a four-day official visit to discuss the proposed agenda for the coming Commonwealth Heads of State meeting to be held in South Africa in November.

He will meet Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad and Foreign Minister Datuk Seri Syed Hamid Albar.

"I am to meet senior heads of State to find out their views before finalising the agenda for the meeting," he said at the Kuala Lumpur International Airport on arrival.

Accompanying Anyaoku was Commonwealth secretariat director of political affairs John Sheppard and his (Anyaoku's) secretary Priscilla Omenai.

Anyaoku was in Australia and will be off to Singapore on Tuesday after his visit here.

He is scheduled to meet Syed Hamid tomorrow and Dr Mahathir on Tuesday in Putrajaya.

He said he was excited to be here.

"This will be my first visit to Putrajaya."
