CHINESE TOLD TO BE WARY OF DAP TACTICS

BUKIT MERTAJAM, Sept 19 (Bernama) -- MCA president Datuk Seri Dr Ling Liong Sik has advised the Chinese community to be wary of DAP's "dangerous tactic" to deny the Barisan Nasional (BN) a two-thirds majority in the next general election.

He said the DAP had hatched a plot to influence the people not to give the BN a two-thirds win in the hope that this could result in the BN failing to form the government.

The DAP knew that the BN would win and was trying to play on the people's sympathy to deny the BN a landslide win, he told reporters after attending MCA's 50th anniversary celebration at Kampung Baru Berapit here tonight.

Dr Ling, who is Transport Minister, said 99 percent of Chinese in the country supported the government and wanted Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad to continue leading the country.

This was because the Prime Minister had taken positive steps to steer the country out of recession, he said.

He said the Chinese community should not be influenced by the DAP and should choose a party capable of bringing growth and economic prosperity.

"We only have one vote, and we cannot afford to make two choices. As such, vote for the Prime Minister's leadership, and not Nik Aziz and his Islamic state," he said.
