42 YEARS OF MALAYSIA'S ECONOMIC SUCCESS UNDER BN RULE

KUALA LUMPUR, Nov 21 (Bernama) -- The Barisan Nasional (BN) has been able to succeed as the ruling government for 42 years because of its ability to continue bringing economic prosperity to Malaysians of all walks of life.

The country's economic success was detailed in the BN manifesto themed "Free, United and Successful Malaysia" that was launched by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad, who is also BN chairman, at the Putra World Trade Centre here today.

Among the achievements highlighted in the 19-page manifesto is that Malaysia has enjoyed the highest growth among developing countries at seven per cent per annum for three decades and having infrastructures comparable to that of developed countries.

The manifesto also lauded the country's ability to withstand the attack by rogue currency traders and formulate and implement wealth distribution policy that benefits all races.

The ruling government is also the driving force in formulating its own approaches to promote economic recovery while keeping foreign reserve high at all time, said the manifesto.

The country is also in strong economic and financial positions without depending on foreign help.

The BN is also successful because Bumiputeras, once backward, have now been able to participate in all areas of commerce and industry, said the manifesto.
