CUEPACS WILL COOPERATE WITH GOVT TO ERADICATE CORRUPTION

IPOH, June 4 (Bernama) -- Cuepacs will cooperate with the government in efforts to eradicate corruption, its President N.Siva Subramaniam said today.

"If we want to create a generation of world class civil servants, we should keep away from corruption and eliminate this activity," he said.

"Cuepacs is happy that corruption is not widespread in Malaysia unlike in other countries but the Deputy Prime Minister's call to civil servants to avoid corruption is timely," he told Bernama.

He noted that government departments had set up their respective units to check corruption and civil servants supported the move as it would enhance the excellence of the civil service.

Siva said Cuepacs welcomed the RM600 special payment to retired civil servants as well to the police and military.

"Cuepacs is grateful to the government for extending the payment to retirees. This is a positive move and will help ensure their welfare."
