DAP LAUNCHES "JUSTICE FOR ALL" CAMPAIGN

PETALING JAYA, Jan 12 (Bernama) -- The DAP today launched a nationwide campaign, dubbed "Justice For All", with the objective to make Malaysia a civil society that upholds justice, freedom, democracy and good governance.

Party chairman Dr Chen Man Hin launched the one-year campaign which arose from the imprisonment of DAP deputy secretary-general Lim Guan Eng four-and-a-half months ago for sedition and false publication.

DAP secretary-general Lim Kit Siang the campaign was not just for Guan Eng but was for everyone.

"I would like to urge all Malaysians to come forward to join, promote and make the campaign a success," he said.

Kit Sing handed over T-shirts, books on Guan Eng's imprisonment in English and Chinese and cassettes and leaflets to state DAP representatives at the launch at the party headquarters, here.

He said although Guan Eng was in Kajang prison, his spirits were high and he fully supported the campaign to ensure that justice was real and alive for all Malaysians.

Guan Eng is currently serving concurrent 18-month jail sentences for two offences under the Sedition Act and the Printing Presses and Publications Act.

Dr Chen, in his speech, called on Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad to resolve the political crisis engulfing the nation and determine a new policy that could ensure peace for all.

The political crisis must be addressed immediately, he said, adding that Dr Mahathir could either call for a general election at once or come up with a policy to resolve the crisis.
