Dr M arrives for three-day visit to Sabah

KOTA KINABALU, Thurs. - Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad, accompanied by wife Datin Seri Dr Siti Hasmah Mohd Ali, arrived tonight for a three-day visit.

Among those at Terminal Two to welcome them were Chief Minister Tan Sri Bernard Dompok, Deputy Chief Minister Datuk Osu Sukam and Minister in the Chief Minister's Department Datuk Yong Teck Lee.

Soon after his arrival, he attended a meet-the-people session at Dewan Masyarakat Menggatal, about 20km from here. Later in the night he met Barisan Nasional candidates in the coming State election.

Tomorrow morning, Dr Mahathir will be meeting religious teachers and imams at Dewan Saadah in Wisma Muis before proceeding to Tuaran, about 35 kilometres from here, to address a meet-the-people session.

He will join Muslims for Friday prayers at Masjid Pengalat Kecil.

In the afternoon, Dr Mahathir will attend another meet-the-people session in Papar and a similar session at the Kota Kinabalu High School in the evening.

On Saturday, the Prime Minister will attend another meet-the-people session at Petagas before leaving for the Federal Territory of Labuan.
