Dr M to unveil Securities Commission's new HQ today

THIRTY-TWO months after its ground-breaking ceremony, the Securities Commission's very own headquarters will be unveiled by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad in Bukit Kiara, Kuala Lumpur, today.

Situated at the corner of Jalan Bukit Kiara and Persiaran Bukit Kiara, the SC headquarters is across the road from both the National Science Centre and Kelab Kiara.

Described as a landmark development, the 11-storey intelligent building will also see the Securities Industry Development Centre among the anchor tenants.

It is designed to provide a cohesive operation centre that complements and caters to the different needs of the SC and the SIDC.

Costing about RM200 million, the building covers a 1.62-hectare site.

Besides an information resource centre, it will also have a technology gallery, cafeteria, surau, classrooms of different sizes, conference hall to hold 800 people and an auditorium with a 400-people capacity.

Since its inception in 1993, the SC was occupying two adjacent buildings along Jalan Semantan.
