DR MAHATHIR LAUNCHES TAMAN BUNGA RAYA BUKIT BERUNTUNG PROJECT

KUALA LUMPUR, March 20 (Bernama) -- Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad handed over the keys to owners of low-cost apartments, Kenanga Apartments, in the Taman Bunga Raya housing project, Bukit Beruntung, near here, today.

The prime minister also launched the medium-cost apartments, Mawar Apartments, in the project developed by Emkay Medan Prestasi Sdn Bhd, a subsidiary of MKN Holdings Bhd.

The Taman Bunga Raya project on 232.4has will have 8,807 low-cost units, 6,600 low-medium-cost and 3,460 medium-cost units with prices ranging from RM35,000 to RM80,000 each when completed.

It will also have 770 shoplots and commercial units and amenities like schools, multipurpose hall, surau, recreation club, swimming pool, garder and childcare centre.

Dr Mahathir also visited the one-stop service centre, which offers services like laundering service, as well as the project site and model house.
