Dr Mahathir to visit Sabah

KOTA KINABALU: Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad will make a two-day working visit to Sabah beginning May 13, Chief Minister Datuk Osu Sukam said yesterday. Accompanying the Prime Minister will be his wife Datin Seri Dr Siti Hasmah Mohd Ali.

Announcing this, Osu said upon arrival the Prime Minister would hold a meeting with Cabinet ministers and heads of departments. In the evening, he will be the guest of honour at a thanksgiving dinner to celebrate the Barisan Nasional victory in the March 12-13 State election.

The following day, the Prime Minister will attend a meet-the-people session in Ranau, about 100 kilometres from here to fulfil a promise made to the people after bad weather prevented him from visiting Ranau during the election campaign on March 11.

Dr Mahathir was to have visited Ranau on April 10 but his scheduled three-day visit to Sabah was put off as he was warded for lung infection.
