DR MAHATHIR WITNESSES SIGNING OF CONDO SALES AGREEMENT

CYBERJAYA, Nov 4 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad today witnessed the signing of an agreement for the sale of 106 units of condominium between Tindak Murni Sdn Bhd, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Country Heights Holdings Berhad (CHHB) and Net-Linx Asia Pacific Sdn Bhd.

CHHB was represented by managing director Tan Sri Lee Kim Yew and Net-Linx, its president Holm Hall Bauer.

Under the agreement Net-Linx will pay RM32.26 million for the condominium units situated within the Multimedia Super Corridor (MSC) in Cyberjaya.

Lee, in his speech said the condominium, known as Cyber Heights Villa, was designed to take advantage of the concept of the MSC environment.

The MSC is a 750 sq km zone south of Kuala Lumpur, designated as the hub for the development of multimedia products and services.

Lee said Cyber Heights residents can equip their units with special sensors connected to a laptop computer or telephone that will control lights and air-conditioners.

There will also be computer plug-in points to the MSC fibre-optic backbone with voice, data or video capabilities, he said.

Net-Linx Asia Pacific is an MSC-status company, newly created as the regional headquarters for one of the world suppliers of integrated software systems for the advertising, telecommunications, information and directory-publishing industries.
