DR MAHATHIR GETS VISIT FROM SULTAN OF SELANGOR

KUALA LUMPUR, April 17 (Bernama) -- The Sultan of Selangor today visited Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad at his private residence at The Mines, Sungai Besi.

The Sultan was accompanied by Tengku Permaisuri Selangor Siti Aishah. Also present was the prime minister's wife, Datin Seri Dr Siti Hasmah Mohd Ali.

The Sultan spent about 30 minutes chatting with Dr Mahathir.

Dr Mahathir is now resting after being warded at the National Heart Institute (IJN) on April 2 following a lung infection on his return from performing the haj in Mecca.

He was discharged from the IJN when his condition improved last Monday but was advised by doctors from the IJN to rest at home before resuming work.

Yesterday, Dr Mahathir received a courtesy call from a group of menteri besar and chief ministers.

Earlier, the prime minister was also visited by the Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Ja'afar, Sultan Hassanal Bolkiah of Brunei and members of his cabinet.
