Dr Mahathir for two-day visit to Johor

JOHOR BARU, Wed. - Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad is scheduled to make a two-day working visit to Johor from March 25.

He will be accompanied by his wife Datin Seri Paduka Dr Siti Hasmah Mohd Ali.

He is scheduled to arrive at the Sultan Ismail Airport at 8.45am where he will be greeted by Johor Menteri Besar Datuk Abdul Ghani Othman.

He will then hold a closed-door meeting with State Umno liaison committee representatives at the Umno Johor building in Jalan Ariffin.

Dr Siti Hasmah will meanwhile meet members of the Johor Association of State Assemblymen's Wives, or Juita, at the Eden Garden Hotel.

The Prime Minister will then hold a meeting with State Umno Liaison Committee, Umno Youth and Wanita Umno representatives at the Eden Garden Hotel.

This will be followed by lunch with State Umno and Barisan Nasional leaders at the hotel.

In the afternoon, the Prime Minister will attend a meet-the-people session at the Sekolah Kebangsaan Felda Pengeli Timur field in Kota Tinggi. That evening, he and Dr Siti Hasmah will attend a dinner given by Ghani and his wife Prof Datin Dr Jamilah Ariffin at the Menteri Besar's official residence.

The following day, the Prime Minister will launch the low-and medium-low cost housing project in Kota Masai, here.

Later that morning, he will attend the ground-breaking ceremony of the new Titan plant in Pasir Gudang.

He will attend Friday prayers at the Masjid Jamek Kampung Kopok Baru and a lunch at the village.

He and Dr Siti Hasmah are due to fly back to Kuala Lumpur at 3.45pm from the Sultan Ismail Airport.
