DR MAHATHIR LEAVES FOR LONDON ENROUTE TO JAMAICA FOR G15 SUMMIT

SEPANG, Feb 5 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad left for London tonight for a two-day working visit before proceeding to Kingston, Jamaica to attend the Group of 15 Developing Countries annual summit.

He was accompanied by his wife Datin Seri Dr Siti Hasmah Mohd Ali.

Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi was among those present at the KL International Airport here to see him off.

Sri Lanka will be admitted as the 17th member at the Kingston summit held from Feb 5 to 12.

The G15, which was incepted in Malaysia in 1990, is aimed at enhancing bilateral cooperation among developing countries.
