ELECTION: IT'S A CHOICE BETWEEN SLANDER AND DEED, SAYS SANUSI

LANGKAWI, Nov 24 (Bernama) -- Kedah Menteri Besar Tan Sri Sanusi Junid today described the 10th general election as a choice between slander and deed.

He said the general election is also to differentiate between peace and disorder.

Sanusi, who is defending his Kuah state seat, said the people should choose correctly if they wanted to see the country to continue to achieve progress and the system of justice maintained.

"Without deed and peace, tourists and investors will not come to the country to spend and invest their money," he said when addressing members of the police force, here.

He said that no one could deny what Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad had done to bring development to the country.

"If there is something to be done, he will be the first to discuss it with the experts," he said.

But, he said, Dr Mahathir and even himself were targets of all sorts of ridiculous accusations, like him having three wives and strong sexual urge.

On PAS, Sanusi said the opposition party was not sincere even to its own candidates contesting in parliamentary seats when it told voters to return them at the state level and the Barisan Nasional (BN) at the federal level.

"If they are not sincere to their own candidates, how can they be sincere to the voters," he told reporters after taking part in a radio programme of RTM RTM Langkawi.

Sanusi is being challenged by PAS candidate Che Din Arshad in his bid to defend the Kuah seat.

He said PAS had also cooled down their campaigning after seeing the people's support to the BN.
