3200 DELEGATES AND 600 OBSERVERS TO ATTEND PPP AGM THIS MONDAY

KUALA LUMPUR, June 5 (Bernama) -- An expected 3200 delegates and 600 observers will attend the 46th People's Progressive Party of Malaysia (PPP) Annual General Meeting (AGM) at Pusat Islam on Monday.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad is scheduled to officiate the one-day meeting which would also be attended by leaders of Barisan Nasional component parties and foreign diplomats.

PPP President Datuk M.Kayveas said today that a total of 21 resolutions would be tabled by delegates, among them expressing full support for the leadership of Datuk Seri Dr. Mahathir Mohamad as Prime Minister to steer the country into the next millennium.

A resolution calling for the implementation of monthly wages for the estate workers and the development of healthcare infrastructure and environment would also be tabled, he said in a statement here.

Kavyeas said amendments to the constitution lowering the party's membership age from 18 to 16 years and to allow the setting-up of branches for wanita wing would also be discussed at the meeting.

Delegates will also deliberate requests for seats in the coming general election, he said.
