FIVE ADDITIONAL POINTS PROPOSED FOR BN MANIFESTO FOR KELANTAN

JELI, Nov 16 (Bernama) -- Kelantan Barisan Nasional (BN) is expected to add on five points to the overall BN manifesto, said Kelantan BN deputy chairman Datuk Mustapa Mohamed.

The additional points would touch on matters determining the future of the people and the state such as economic, political and social developments, he said after opening the Sekolah Kebangsaan Gemang Parents-Teachers Association meeting here today.

He said Kelantan Umno chief Tengku Razaleigh Hamzah would submit the proposal for the additional points to BN chairman Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad today.

"We should know of the outcome for the proposal in a day or two," he said.

Mustapa said among the additional points proposed included the building of a university in Kelantan.

On lies spread by the opposition, he said people, especially in the rural areas, who fell for such tactics sometimes forget that they had benefitted from the BN government's assistance such as being recipients of the Amanah Saham Bumiputera (ASB) scheme.

He added the BN government had done all it could to ensure economic development and progress would continue as well as defending the country's independence.
