Food firm, marketing unit donate RM6,150

KOTA BARU, Sat. - Donations for the Barisan Bertindak Kosovo Fund continue to pour in with another RM6,153.02 raised by a health food and herbal medicine manufacturer and its marketing company in Kelantan.

The money was raised by Seri MH Ummi Sdn Bhd and SF Minda Sdn Bhd from promoters, dealers and staff at their branch offices in various States.

"We set up a collection centre at all our branch offices to raise money for the Kosovars," said Seri MH Ummi managing director Abdullah Beeran.

The cheque was handed to Kota Baru NST staff correspondent Manisah Ismail by SF Minda Sdn Bhd managing director Ibrahim Ismail yesterday.

In Klang, the People's Progressive Party Klang division, today launched a charity car wash to raise RM10,000 for the fund.

Launching the event at the Selangor Coast Club, Selangor PPP chairman Alex Thiagarasan said they were confident of raising the money.
