Gerakan to get feedback on members' support

PANTAI REMIS, Fri. - Gerakan divisional and branch leaders have started gauging the support of members for the coming polls.

They will be compiling the information into a report to be submitted to the Barisan Nasional headquarters. Party president Datuk Seri Dr Lim Keng Yaik said leaders would assess members' attitudes and support for BN as well as listen to opinions and grouses.

"We will make sure that members sincerely support the ruling coalition and any BN candidate, regardless of whether they are from Gerakan," he told reporters after a dialogue with the Kim Poh Leong temple committee members at Kampung Raja Hitam today.
