Gift of two motorcycles for Negri Sembilan police

SAMSUNG Electronics Seremban Complex recently donated two Modenas Kriss motorcycles for State police use.

The motorcycles were handed over by Samsung Electronics Group Malaysia president Kim Jong Ki to a representative of the State branch of the Malaysian Crime Prevention Foundation (MCPF) Datuk Tan Kim Chong during a brief ceremony.

In his speech, Kim said the company wanted to assist the police force in the State in upgrading their services to the public.

Kim said public awareness on crime prevention was essential as this would enable the public to play an active role in helping police prevent crime.

He said the gift was part of the company's community service project and he hoped that other corporate bodies would follow their footsteps.

The Malaysian Crime Prevention Foundation was launched by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad on Jan 12, 1993 while the Negri Sembilan MCPF branch was set up on Feb 4, 1995.
