INTEGRITY OF JUDICIAL SYSTEM ACKNOWLEDGED

KUALA LUMPUR, Aug 8 (Bernama) -- The integrity of the country's judicial system, especially the independence of the judiciary, is acknowledged by all, said Deputy Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Datuk Paduka Ibrahim Ali.

"The independence of the judiciary has been questioned in the last few months but in the end, all the allegations were proven to be baseless," he said.

Ibrahim, met after the Bar Council's Family Day and Walkaton here today, said he was happy that the integrity in the judicial system has been acknowledged by all.
