KELANTAN UMNO SATISFIED WITH LOYALTY OF DIVISION LEADERS

KOTA BAHARU, May 10 (Bernama) -- Kelantan Umno has no doubt about its divisional leaders' loyalty to the party and Umno president Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

Kelantan Umno deputy chief Datuk Annuar Musa said he based this on the high level of commitment shown by the divisional leaders to the party.

"Kelantan Umno practises the spirit of unity, and if there are problems we will sit down together and resolve them amicably," he told reporters here today.

He said this when commenting on Umno secretary-general Datuk Sabbaruddin Chik's statement that 11 Umno leaders previously linked to the "reformasi" movement were still placed under the Supreme Council's observation list. They include Tumpat division chief Datuk Kamaruddin Jaafar and Pasir Puteh division head Kamarudin Mohd Nor.

Annuar said Kelantan Umno did not doubt the loyalty of the Tumpat and Pasir Puteh division chiefs because they had shown a sense of commitment and unity.

He said Kelantan Umno would not make wild allegations against members and those implicated in any issue would be given a chance to explain.

Annuar urged divisional leaders to maintain unity and to discuss problems through the proper channels.

He said those who liked to question the loyalty of other members should look at themselves first.
